MANDATORY ELECTRONIC VOTING




Whereas, local governments should maintain authority over decisions based on voter turnout and financial burden placed on township's budget

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the town board of Straight River Hubbard County, Minnesota, does not support the requirement that every polling place in Minnesota be required to utilize precinct-based optical scan vote tabulating equipment as proposed in House File 1703.
