**WHEREAS**, a provision was included in the State Government Finance bill House File 1481 (Article 2, Section 3) and is as follows:

"A county, town, school district, or statutory or home rule charter city may file a written resolution with the State Auditor objecting to a state mandate or making recommendations for reforming a state mandate. The State Auditor must list on the State Auditor's web site a list of all state mandates cited in a resolution under this section, and the name of the unit of the local government citing the mandate", and

**WHEREAS**, Minnesota Statute 253B.045, Subd. 2 and 3 state that counties pay for the commitment of psychosexual predators referred from prison who are to be committed to a State institution, and

**WHEREAS**, when sexual psychopaths and sexually dangerous persons complete their prison terms, counties may try to commit them to State mental institutions after release, and

**WHEREAS**, adjudicating these cases takes a lot of time and the cost of housing these offenders at St. Peter's facility is expensive,

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the State should fully pay or share the cost of this placement until the offender is formally released.
