WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes are prospective as to how the burial of the indigent is to be  
conducted.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Carlton County Board of Commissioners does  
hereby propose that counties be given the ability to proscribe the type of burial for the  
indigent and further that if an alternative method to the county burial is desired by  
another party, that the counties be limited as to the amount they contribute for that  
purpose.
