WHEREAS: Local governments should be able to make the decision about what is the most cost effective election process for their township.


WHEREAS: HAVA grant covers the initial cost of the machine but the cost of training, programming and testing will become the responsibility of the townships.


WHEREAS: Mandating electronic machines for local government elections puts an undue hardship on township budgets.
