PAUL (5/11/2009)** – The National State Auditors Association (NSAA) announced that the *Best Practices Review: Reducing Energy Costs in Local Government* issued by State Auditor Rebecca Otto in July of 2008 has won a prestigious 2009 NSAA Excellence in Accountability Award in the Special Projects category.
