Results- Of the 4,095 ballots that the M100 Machine counted for the three precincts chosen, the hand count came up with 4,096 or a difference of 1 or a .0244% difference. This was the result of voter intent determined on the ballot, by the hand count. The machine counted the ballot as an over vote. Or a 99.9755% accuracy rate.
