#### 3. Reminder: Relief Association Annual Business Renewal

Every volunteer fire relief association must annually register as a nonprofit corporation with the Minnesota Secretary of State's Office. If a relief association fails to register or to notify the Secretary of State of corporate name or address changes, the Secretary of State may reject the registration and dissolve the relief association's nonprofit corporation status.

A relief association can learn of its current registration status by going to the Secretary of State's website. Relief associations with a "renewal due date" displayed as 12/31/2014 must complete the registration before December 31, 2014 or face dissolution of the association's nonprofit corporation status. If the relief association has completed its registration for this calendar year, the renewal due date will be displayed as 12/31/2015.
