## County Correction of Errors Reminder

A 2008 amendment to the TIF Act permits county auditors to correct errors in certification or decertification of a TIF district or errors in computation of tax increment. County auditors now have the flexibility to recertify a district or certify the original tax capacity of affected parcels, extend the duration of a district, or adjust tax rates to correct the effect of an error. When this statutory authority is used, the county must provide documentation of the correction to the Commissioner of Revenue and the State Auditor.
