#### 3. Reminder: Relief Association Economic Interest Statements

Every year, each volunteer fire relief association board member and chief administrative officer is required to complete a *Statement of Economic Interest*. The Statement must be filed with the chief administrative officer of the relief association and be made available for public inspection.

The chief administrative officer of a relief association must also submit a *Certified Listing of Individuals Who Filed a Statement of Economic Interest* form to the Campaign Finance and Public Disclosure Board by **January 15, 2020**. This form must list all individuals who have filed *Statements of Economic Interest* with the relief association for the preceding 12 months, along with the address of the office at which the statements are available for public inspection.

#### 6. Avoiding Pitfalls: IRS Form W-2 and Form 1099

Local governments are required to file IRS Form W-2 to report employee wages, tips, and other compensation. In addition, entities need to file Form 1099-MISC for non-employees who received \$600 or more for their services.
