(a) Data on Life Expectancy come from the National Center for Health Statistics (NCHS) through the National Vital Statistics System (NVSS). The most recent data available are two to four years prior to the reporting date, and are therefore estimates of the current Life Expectancy at birth.

(b) There are multiple family and system related factors that can affect the maltreatment recurrence performance measure. Our Federal Standard for this is to be less than 9.1%. The state average is 9.0%. Factors could include but not limited to; specific type of allegations being reported, efforts to decrease placement, increased drug use by families etc. Note that 2018 is almost the same percentage as 2016 in spite of 64 more maltreatment incidences in 2018.

(c) The reduction in the compliance percentange is related with the migration to a new system during the Covid-19 Pandemic. Statute allows a temporary suspension of compliance with recording documents related to the migration to a new system.

(d) 2018 Library visits were down due to the Centennial Library being closed for 4 months for a significant remodel. 2020 Library visits were impacted by closures due to COVID-19 Pandemic.
