The State Auditor must list on the State Auditor's web site a list of all state mandates cited in a resolution under this section, and the name of the unit of the local government citing the mandate", and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statue Chapter 115A (the Waste Management Act) requires waste management reporting to the PCA, OEA and SCORE, now

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that Pine County does hereby request that waste management reporting to the PCA, OEA and SCORE is condensed into one report to cover all facilities, grants, etc.
