WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute §6.79 allows local governments to submit to the State Auditor proposed reforms to state mandates; and

WHEREAS, mandate proposals will be listed on the State Auditor's website, along with the name of the local government submitting the proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Hubbard County Board of Commissioners supports the concept of mandate reform and urges the Minnesota Legislature to give serious consideration to all proposals made by Counties.

Now, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Hubbard County Board of Commissioners hereby adopts the following mandate relief proposals and directs the County Coordinator to submit this listing to the State Auditor:

MS §345.31 to §345.60 — Eliminate requirement for local governments to turn unclaimed property in the form of outstanding checks over to the Minnesota Department of Commerce.

By continuing the requirement that local governments report and disclose unclaimed property including outstanding checks to the Department of Commerce, the process of advertising and searching for the owners can continue to take place. Allowing local governments to keep the property until such time as an owner comes forward will keep the funds at the same levy from which they were funded.
