RESOLUTION 29-12

DECLARATION OF PARTICIPATION IN THE PERFORMANCE MEASUREMENT PROGRAM AND FILING OF THE 2012 PERFORMANCE MEASUREMENT PROGRAM REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

WHEREAS, on June 14, 2011, the Renville County Board of Commissioners voted to participate in the Performance Measurement Program created by the Council on Local Results and Innovations; and

WHEREAS, Renville County understands that by electing to participate in the standard measures program for 2012, that Renville County is eligible for a reimbursement of \$0.14 per capita in local government aid, not to exceed \$25,000, and is also exempt from levy limits under Minnesota Statutes, Sections 275.70 to 275.74, for taxes payable in 2013, if levy limits are in effect; and

WHEREAS, by July 1, 2012, Renville County understands that annual reporting to the Office of the Minnesota State Auditor will be required by the County to participate in the program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT The Renville County Board of Commissioners agrees to continue to participate in the Performance Measurement Program created by the Council on Local Results and Innovations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT Renville County has adopted and implemented ten performance measures developed by the Council on Local Results and Innovation and agreed to by the Office of the State Auditor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT Renville County has implemented a local performance measurement system as developed by the Council on Local Results and Innovation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT Renville County will report the results of the ten adopted measures to its residents before the end of the calendar year by posting the results on the County's website.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVES THAT Renville County will survey its residents by the end of the calendar year on the services included in the adopted performance benchmarks that require survey results to establish output measures for a performance benchmark.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, THAT Renville County will submit to the Office of the State Auditor the actual results of the performance measures adopted by the County.

The following are the most recent performance measurement reporting results for Renville County.

Public Safety:

(1) Part 1 Crime Rates: Total Part 1 Crimes 2011, 68
Part 2 Crime Rates: Total Part 2 Crimes 2011, 243

Public Works:

- (2) Hours to plow complete system during a snow event: All 17 plow routes covering 710 miles of roadway are cleared in an 8 hrs shift assuming moderate snowfall covers the entire county.
- (3) Average county pavement condition rating: 3.1

Public Health:

- (4) Behavior Risk Factor Surveillance System Rating: The most recent data available for this set of indicators is from 2010. From the factors in this ratings system, Renville County has chosen to follow three to trend:
 - (a) Among sexually active students: percent reporting always using a condom 9th grade 61% 12th grade 46%
 - **(b)** Percent of 9th graders who ate five or more servings of fruit, fruit juice, or and vegetables yesterday: 17%
 - (c) Years of potential life lost before age 65 due to unintentional injury or violence: 157.5

(a) MFIP recipients: 33.3%(b) DWP recipients: 42.8%

(6) Percentage of children where there is a recurrence of maltreatment within 12 months following an intervention: 0%

(9) Percentage of Veterans surveyed who said their questions were answered when seeking benefit information from their County Veterans' Office: 100%

Parks:

- (10) Many good comments and improvement ideas where collected by citizens' rating of the quality of County parks, recreational programs, and/or facilities surveys (40% of surveys where returned):
 - 100% surveyed had no problem with electricity or water supply at the County park
 - Of those that used the bathrooms upkeep was rated as "Fair"
 - In general the feeling of cleanliness/ maintenance and safety of the park were noted equally as "Often or Sometimes"
 - 100% surveyed felt the dumpsters onsite were adequate
 - The overall opinions of the quality of the park were noted equally as "Very Good to Fair".
