Whereas, Minnesota Statute § 282.04 limits "Over-the-Counter" or "Section 1" timber sales to private individuals to no more than \$3,000.00 in appraised value, and

Whereas, with current pricing structures and management objectives, this dollar limit decreases the efficiency and increases the costs of County Land Departments to manage small-area and difficult access tracts of forest land, now

Be it resolved, this dollar limit needs to be changed by either increasing the dollar limit or changing the limit to an acreage limit.
